Article Submission



# What's the process for getting published in Practitioner Perspectives ?

1

## Send proposal for article

To be e-mailed to [contact@practitionercircle.com](mailto:contact@practitionercircle.com) using Proposal Form template

The proposal should contain

- Title of Article, Abstract with summary of key concepts
- Author Biography
- Why does the author think that this topic is relevant to today's practitioners

Optional but recommended step

2

## Receive & analyze initial feedback

The editorial team will get back to the author (usually in 3-5 business days)

The response will contain

- Acceptance, Rejection or Suggestions for changes to the article concept
- Deadline for submission of article, if accepted

Optional but recommended step

Editorial Decision	Description
Acceptance	We are interested in this article and would like to consider it for publication
Suggestions	We would consider this article provided some suggestions are incorporated
Rejection	We are sorry, we would not be able to publish this article

# What's the process for getting published in **Practitioner Perspectives** ?

## **Complete & send the article for review**

To be e-mailed to [contact@practitionercircle.com](mailto:contact@practitionercircle.com) using *Article Submission* template

4

## **Receive & analyze editor feedback**

The editorial team will get back to the author (usually in 10 business days)

The response will contain

- Acceptance, Major or Minor Revisions, or Rejection of the article

---

<b>Editorial Decision</b>	<b>Description</b>
Acceptance	The article will be published in the next edition of Practitioner Perspectives
Minor Revisions	The article will be published in the next edition of Practitioner Perspectives, with minor changes
Major Revisions	The article will be published in the next edition of Practitioner Perspectives, only if the author agrees to make the major revisions in time for publication
Rejection	The article wouldn't be published in the next edition of Practitioner Perspectives, but we encourage you to share submissions for future editions

# What type of articles are of interest to **Practitioner Perspectives** ?

What's <b>HOT</b> for Practitioner Perspectives	What's <b>NOT</b> for Practitioner Perspectives
Original and “Never Before Published”, Thought Provoking articles and papers	Articles that are not original or too vague
Themes related to Testing & QA, Leadership, Project Management, Business Analysis	Articles that are advertisements in disguise
Practical experiences & stories that need to be told	Articles and themes that are not directly relevant to our areas of interest
Well articulated arguments written in clear and easy to understand fashion	Articles using flawed logic, too many errors

## **Why should I publish my article in Practitioner Perspective ?**

## **What are the authors paid for contributing an article ?**

## **What file format should I use for submissions ?**

Please use the 'proposal for article' form and the 'article submission' form for the documents. These are available on the Practitioner Circle website for you to use.

**What additional steps do I need to take when my article is accepted ?**  
You will need to submit an author consent form, your latest photograph in digital format and updated copy of the article itself.

**Can I directly submit my article without sending a proposal first ?**  
Yes, you could. However, we recommend the proposal step for saving time of authors and the editorial team.

**Can I include images and screenshots in my article ?**  
Yes, we love articles that have pictures! Please ensure that these are high quality images and are also included as an attachment in the submission email.

**What's the optimum length of an article ?**

Use as many words you think you need to convey the message! We would recommend anywhere between 1000 to 6000 words.

**Is any past writing experience needed for writing in you magazine ?**

No, not at all. We are looking for new, great content that is relevant and hasn't been published already.
